FOR THE WEEK OF June 8th - The Feast of Pentecost

MEMORY VERSE: Ezekiel 36:26 – And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh.

STEWARDSHIP THOUGHT: Acts 2:1 – "When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all together in one place." Notice that Pentecost was actually an Old Testament festival. It happened around the time when the wheat and oats were ready to be brought in. In the New Testament, Pentecost foreshadowed the great harvest of humankind that God will bring in through the preaching of His Word. God gives the seed, and God brings about the harvest through the work of His church.

LIFE THOUGHT – Words about the worth and purpose invested in every human being belong not to us alone but to Almighty God Himself (John 14:24). Our Savior graciously endows the Words of Life with the Holy Spirit's power (John 14:26).
