LCMS MEMORY VERSE: 2 Timothy 2:13

If we are faithless, He remains faithful — for He cannot deny Himself.

LCMS STEWARDSHIP THOUGHT: 1 Corinthians 1:20 – “Where is the one who is wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the debater of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the world?”

God’s ways are certainly not the world’s ways, including the way God tells us to manage the resources He’s given to us.
